Dear Mayor Villaraigosa:


This is a country of law and as such I expect you, under oath to uphold and defend it, to do just that.

On Monday, January 3, 2011, I received two checks from Los Angeles City Controller Wendy Greuel; one for \$2,386.89 and the other for \$208.18, a copy of each herein enclosed. The checks for \$2,386.89 and \$208.18 are for vested right retirement benefits. Vested right retirement benefits do not conform to the full retirement benefits due a thirty year employee of the LADWP.

The 14th Amendment states: My property rights, which are my retirement benefits, cannot be abridged. Nor shall I be deprived of said property in the absence of due process of law. As a constituent under your jurisdiction I expect equal protection of these laws.

Not only did I return these two checks, forthwith, but I expect you to be responsible for the checks respecting the full enforcement of the law retroactive to and including the period from March 11, 2009 to the present and forward.
